Bundesverband e.V. "This includes obtaining certain necessary qualifications. These are essential for carrying out work on high-voltage components safely and in accordance with the regulations." For this reason, a comprehensive training programme has been developed as an industry standard that enables high-voltage specialists to carry out their work with the necessary expertise and accuracy. As part of this training course, participants learn how to work competently and safely with electric drives in the range of up to 1000 V alternating current (AC) or up to 1500 V direct current (DC).

"The high-quality training course developed by the LandBauTechnik Bundesverband is geared towards the special requirements of agricultural and construction machinery technology," said Achim Hauschild, Head of the GRANIT Academy.
